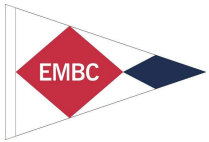

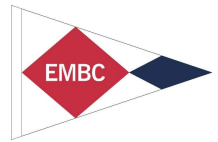

Time: 7:30 P.M.

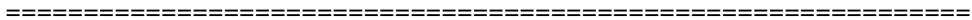
