When you go to buy bread in the grocery store, have you ever wondered which is the freshest? So you "squeeze" for freshness or softness. Did you know that bread is delivered fresh to the stores five days a week? That is Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Each day has a different color twist tie.

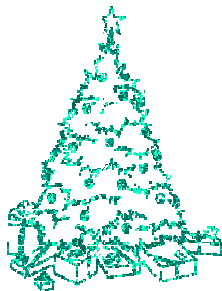
