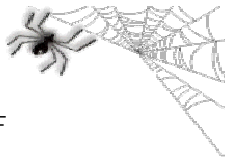

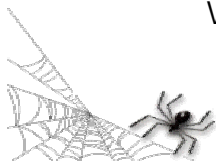

It is a download of 10mb, but well worth it. <http://earth.google.com/> Once you set it up type in any address...like for instance "Edgewater Marina Cleveland" or just scroll around the globe, then play with the controls at the bottom to manipulate the scene, big cities even have 3D buildings. You can turn many options on and off, such as roads, boundaries and other things. The controls will allow you to zoom in anywhere on earth. You can even see the crib!

**Full Harvest Moon – September 17** This is the full Moon that occurs closest to the autumn equinox. In two years out of three, the Harvest Moon comes in September, but in some years it occurs in October. At the peak of harvest, farmers can work late into the night by the light of this Moon. Usually the full Moon rises an average of 50 minutes later each night, but for the few nights around the Harvest Moon, the Moon seems to rise at nearly the same time each night: just 25 to 30 minutes later across the U.S., and only 10 to 20 minutes later for much of Canada and Europe. Corn, pumpkins, squash, beans, and wild rice the chief Native American staples are now ready for gathering.

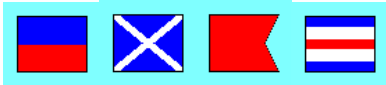
